## BETTA-VIEW BACK-PACK FOOD PROGRAM IS OFF TO A GOOD START!

Thousands of kids in our area count on the government's free and reduced meals available at school to alleviate their hunger. During weekends and holidays, when the schools are not open, these children do not have a ready source of food so they either eat what they can find or go hungry until Monday morning when the schools open.

And people ask, "are there children in this general area that go hungry?" The answer is "absolutely." Since 2000 the child poverty rate has increased by 18%, meaning that the economic recession of the past few years effectively wiped out all of the gains we made in cutting child poverty in the late 1990's. Alabama ranked a miserable 46<sup>th</sup>! (Kids Count Data, 2011)

We at Betta-View can't solve this problem alone, but we can do our part to help a few. That's where our Back-Pack food program kicks in. The Back-Pack program is already underway in most of the Oxford area elementary schools, but it was brought to our attention that there were 30 kids at the Coosa Valley Elementary School in Pell City that had either limited or no food to eat over the weekends. These kids were identified by the teachers, counselors and Principal. The problem at Coosa Valley was solved this past week through Betta-View's new Back-Pack food program. The items provided to each of these kids in their back pack may change going forward, but this past Friday we provided each of these 30 children the following food items:

This is enough food to get them through the weekend. We will furnish the food to the school on a monthly basis, and the school will distribute on a weekly basis.

Each member at Betta View is encouraged to be involved in this new program which will be headed-up by James Galbreath, under the oversight of the elders. Each week, we will list two or three of the Back-Pack items (as shown above) in the bulletin and ask that you furnish the requested items. We are unable to provide any type of peanut butter or nut items due to allergies that a certain number of the kids may have. Items not furnished by members will be bought at reduced prices from our suppliers. Keep in mind, the more food that is furnished by our members means more kids that we can help.

Each month we will be packing-the-bags to be included in the Back Packs. We hope you will become involved in this packing process. If you can help, please see James Galbreath. A special thanks to those who came out on short notice last Tuesday and got the process underway!
