The Ability To Laugh At Yourself



There are some people that can't take a joke. It's as if you need their permission to laugh with them.

Perhaps you know people like this. They are serious people – especially about themselves. They might tell a joke or tease with others, but you don't feel as if you can join in. *It's not that these people are unpleasant or mean*. They're just serious – at least when it comes to you.

Let's try to laugh at ourselves. It sure makes life more comfortable.
