1. 2 Corinthians 7:10

We can't undo the past, and we usually just make things worse when we try.

1. Lesson from Israel

Regret becomes <u>destructive</u> when we can't move on from our sins and mistakes.

Regret is <u>unhealthy</u> when it leads to an attitude of hopelessness.

Regret leads to <u>apathy</u>, paralysis, an unwillingness to seek God's blessing.

### IS THIS HOW YOU FEEL?

We don't have to be paralyzed by regret.

## How do you get past your past?

1. We need to adjust our theology
