Who Wants A Better Future?



What you do in the next day, week, or month really can impact the future. Yet - so many of us are waiting. We wait and think that one day life will be better. It will be better "as soon as."

Maybe you have said it: Life will get better as soon as:

- our marriage becomes what it should be.
- we pay off the house. we can afford to travel.

The list could go on and on. We think there are roadblocks or limitations that somehow keep us from really experiencing life. As soon as this or that happens, life will be good again.

If you are like many, you think of it in terms of "some day". Someday, my marriage will be what it ought to be. Someday, I will spend more time with my family. Someday, I will be attentive to my relationship to God. Someday, I will finally have the job I've always wanted. Someday, I will be a part of a great church. Someday, everything will finally come together.

Follow are four suggestions that can give you a much better future.



There's A Stirring Haggai 1:12-15

As long as you have <u>breath</u>- *it's never too late to do what's right*.

In vs. 8, God was very specific on what He wanted them to do:

- "Go up into the mountains and bring down timber and build my house, so that I may take pleasure in it and be honored."
- 2. Vs. 12 begins like this: "THEN"

Principle to remember: "Delayed <u>disobedience</u> is still <u>disobedience</u>"

Last part of vs. 12: "**And the people <u>feared</u> the Lord**."

 Matthew Henry commentary: "A holy <u>fear</u> of God will have a great influence upon our obedience to Him...if we <u>fear</u> Him not, we shall not <u>serve</u> Him."

How does God make things work out?

First, He promises, "<u>I Am With You</u>." (1:13) 1. Isaiah 41:10; Matthew 28:20; Romans 8:31:

When we *surrender to God* – He promises to make His presence known in our lives.

Second, He stirs our spirits (1:14).

Philippians 2:12-13: "Continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, **for it is God who works in you** to will and to act according to His good purpose."

Let's be very careful to avoid two extremes:

- 1. The first thing is not to act when you <u>experi-</u> <u>ence</u> a stirring.
- 2. The second is to avoid serving in your own <u>power</u> without any stirring from the Spirit.

We can do great things because He is with us.
