# The Great Commission



It is amazing to me that the last words of Jesus in the gospel of Matthew have been given the nickname, *The Great Commission*. I don't know when it became known by that moniker, but at some point, these words were so valuable that they were given their own name.

Most of the time when we quote *The Great Commission* we begin with "*Go into the world*", but that isn't where Jesus started. 
