We all have opinions on issues and matters. That doesn't mean we need to put it out there for the world to see. We are first and foremost followers of Jesus Christ, and everything else follows after that. If what we post leads people to think otherwise, perhaps we should reconsider.

I hope you recall what I said last week. "I don't care what people think of me" is NOT a Christian attitude. If your post makes you appear unloving (even to those with whom you disagree), wait a few minutes before you hit enter. Perhaps you'll change your mind.


