Public Figures and Not-So-Private Failings



The news stories come at a non-stop pace. It's a football player suspended for cheating. Next, it's a governor exposed for lying and infidelity. Then there's the constant bizarre behavior and rehab for a music star.

There will be more. Count on it. And one of the most common and off-putting responses we will hear in every case is this: "What so-and-so does in private life has nothing to do with his or her public abilities."

At one level, that's right. The ability to paint the corner of the plate with a fastball, belt out a mesmerizing concert, draw business to the state – all these abilities exist independently of dumb, criminal, or evil things somebody does. That is, for now anyway..... until the next temptation or blackmail threat based on the last gaffe.

At a much deeper level, however, the connection between personal ethics and public persona is apparent. If he will lie to and cheat on his wife, he is not trustworthy in anything he promises us. If she is out of control, she is on the way to self-destruction and is going to take others down too. And there are not enough laws or enforcement agents to make things work right.

Have we really come to a point in human history where results, advantage, and effectiveness are more important than character – or the lack of it? Will we tolerate anybody and anything that turns a profit – without regard to harm done to others?

If this sounds like a diatribe against corrupt politicians, celebrities who muddy kids' minds and athletes who smear the legitimacy of sport, it is. But it's the smaller part. The much *larger* point is to remind all us parents, bosses, and teachers that we are **more** than our jobs. Who we are is at the heart of what we do. Character either legitimates or undermines everything we claim to value.

In his Sermon on the Mount, Jesus said: "By their fruit you will recognize them. Do people pick grapes from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? Likewise every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, and a bad tree cannot bear good fruit" (Matthew 7:16-18).

To be an honorable human being is to be decent in the dark as well as before the cameras. It is everyone's challenge these days.


