Callousness is how some people try to find their way to peace. But what they think is peace is really an imposter. Making yourself indifferent to the world around you might numb the senses but it does not bring true peace. True peace doesn't come through withdrawal; rather, it is found in living in and through difficult circumstances while recognizing that we don't have to allow those things to make us anxious or afraid.


