Discipleship, Acceptance, and Grace

At least 20 times in the Gospels Jesus says, "Follow me." Is there any greater invitation in all of scripture than for the Son of God to invite sinful people to walk in His steps?

When we define discipleship, it's usually summarized as our following Jesus Christ. But actually, it can be viewed from two perspectives. We typically think of discipleship from the point of view of the follower. That's only natural since that is our own experience as a disciple of Jesus Christ. But that's only half of it.

What does Jesus' call us to follow Him say about how He views us? It involves acceptance. Would Jesus call someone to follow Him if He didn't accept them for the person they are? I am not saying Jesus turns a blind eye toward sin or unrighteousness, but I am saying Jesus loves everyone and is willing to meet them where they are.

Acceptance is a powerful thing. We all want it. We want it from friends, family and even strangers, so it only makes sense that we want it from God. The biggest self-imposed roadblock in our minds are our own imperfections. We know that our biggest imperfection is our sin. Isn't it amazing is that Jesus chose His disciples from among the ordinary people? He wasn't looking for the big shots or the "most righteous" because in God's eyes, because compared to God, there are no big shots. No. Here's how He chose to accept us. "It is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God" — Ephesians 2:8

Our being accepted by God and becoming His disciples is an act of grace. And in return, He wants us to see ourselves from His perspective. If we do, we can develop a healthier identity in Christ. We'll be able to forgive ourselves of past mistakes, and extend that same grace to others around us.

Well-rounded discipleship necessitates our understanding of how the Master views His followers.
