Being a Successful Church

We all want this church to succeed. But how can that be measured? What are the characteristics of a successful church? I know there are many, but here are a few.

A successful church talks about Jesus all the time. Their main focus isn't their building, their budget or their bottom line, it's Jesus. They don't have gimmicks, they have Jesus. He's at the center of everything they do and teach.

Successful churches communicate clearly. The key to success in real estate is location, location, location. The key to success in most all the areas of the church is communication, communication, communication. Use bulletins, newsletters, handouts, email and websites to communicate. You cannot over communicate your visions, goals and plans.

A church that is succeeding will involve people. Healthy churches have people who are plugged in. The people need to know they are needed.

A successful church must use the Bible. It's the best book ever. It's full of answers for people's lives. Don't tell me that if you teach from the bible, people won't come - nothing is further from the truth.

A church won't succeed if there isn't a BIG emphasis on children. You cannot put enough emphasis on the youth and children. VBS, bible classes, youth functions and youth ministers are all valuable assets in reaching, teaching and raising youth.

A successful church will teach the Bible in a way people can understand. A lesson taught or preached without any application is a huge mistake. People must be challenged. People need practical lessons that will help in their daily lives. God didn't make the bible difficult, so churches shouldn't either.

A church that succeeds will have opened their arms and lives to others. Healthy churches know that there are times when physical needs are more important than spiritual needs. As they old saying goes, "People don't care about what you know, till they know how much you care." The church is not just about learning Christianity it's about LIV-ING it.

Successful churches are actively involved in outreach. One of the traits of a healthy church is they are always looking for ways to reach out to the lost around them. Their mission is to share the good news. And they remind themselves regularly, "Keep the main thing, the main thing."

Successful churches have leaders who lead. If the leadership is passive and unwilling to set an example... the church will follow. But when leaders stand up and go to work, so will the church.

If we want our church to be successful, we must create an atmosphere where people will want to bring their unchurched friends. The church needs to be a safe environment where people can bring my family or friends without them getting their "hides nailed to the wall."

Those are just a few characteristics of a vibrant, successful church. What would you add to the list?
