Happiness vs Holiness

There's an old saying: "God is more interested in you being holy than happy." There are lots of people in the church who try and put emphasis on questions that revolve around that quote, such as "Are you chasing holiness or happiness?" But when dwelling on these, another question arises in my mind: "Are they missing the mark?"

Now it's certainly appropriate to push back on culturally defined "happiness" (consumer-centered materialism, sexual liberation, and self-centeredness in all its many forms). It's great to push back on the idea that holiness is not what is most essential in the Christian's life. God does not exist as some astronomical Santa Claus for our wants. God self-exists outside of us.

But the issue here I want to address is those trying to separate **holiness** from **happiness**. In fact, the only way to be the true meaning of happy is to make yourself holy; set apart from the world. John Piper puts it this way, "Happiness is part of holiness. If you tried to describe for me what it means to be a holy person, leaving out happiness in God, you can't do it. There is no such thing as holiness minus happiness in God. Happiness in God is-I will risk it-the essence of holiness."

Of course, God's word has plenty to say on this matter. The Psalmists often talk about those who are "blessed" or truly happy, and how they are the ones who are, in some measure, truly holy. And let's not forget Jesus' words on the matter in Matthew 5:2-12. He spends these verses talking about how blessed are the ones who put Him first in various ways, whether it be through hardships, sorrows, or otherwise. The blessed people are the ones who understand the profound reality that our sins must be permanently and forever removed before a holy God. The beauty of justification in Christ bridges happiness and holiness that the world tries to separate. However incompletely, Christians taste this true happy-holiness as we live our marriage in Christ. In Christ, we find the inseparable connection between our obedience and our joy, between our pursuit of true holiness and our experience of true happiness.
