Jesus entered the world to serve. We can enter our jobs, our homes, our churches. Servanthood requires no unique skill or college degree. Regardless of your strengths, training, or church tenure, you can

Love the overlooked. Jesus sits in your classroom, wearing the thick glasses, outdated clothing, and a sad face. You've seen Him. He's Jesus.

When you talk to the lonely student, befriend the weary mom, you love Jesus. He dresses in the garb of the overlooked and ignored. "Whenever you did one of these things to someone overlooked and ignored, that was Me - you did it to Me." (Matt. 25:40 MSG).

You can also:

Wave a white flag. We fight so much.

"Where do you think all these appalling wars and quarrels come from?" asks the brother of Jesus. "Do you think they just happen? Think again. They come about because you want your own way, and fight for it deep inside yourselves." (James 4:1 MSG).
