The Importance of Keeping Our Promises

Of all the heroes in scripture, certainly Joshua would rank among the favorites. Do you remember the story about the Israelites when they entered the Promised Land? Some of the neighboring people, the Gibeonites, figured they couldn't defeat the Israelites in battle, so they resorted to trickery. They put on old shoes, pulled wineskins out of the trash, and collected moldy bread. Then they set out on the short hike to the Israelite camp in Gilgal. God had told His people not to make any treaties with the people in the land, but these people claimed to live far, far away and they gave honor to God.

Without consulting God for his direction they made a covenant with the deceptive Gibeonites only to find out that they lived nearby!

The Israelites were in a bind. On one hand God had commanded them to destroy everyone in the land. On the other hand He commanded them to make good on their oaths. Today this treaty would never stand. Written on lies and false pretenses it wouldn't make it through a court of law.

Avoiding the loophole:

They didn't look for a loophole on how to weasel out of their contractual obligations. Instead they honored it and spared these people. But that's not all. In Joshua 10, the Gibeonites were attacked and called on Israel for help. If Israel wanted a way out of the treaty, there it was. They could have let the attackers defeat the Gibeonites, which would have rid the land of them and, and it would have made the treaty null and void. Instead, they marched all night and defeated the attackers, rescuing the Gibeonites.

Zealously upholding our integrity:

I am amazed at the zeal by which they stood by their word. They made a promised and they were going to do everything in their power to keep it, even if it was dangerous and uncomfortable.

All of our actions that people see teach them something about the God we claim to serve. If they see us as honorable and true to our word, that has a positive reflection on God. If we claim to be Christ followers and yet are not trustworthy to those around us, what are we teaching them about the God we say we're trying to be like?

Let us all be true to our word, careful of what we promise, and go to great lengths to show ourselves to be a people of honor and integrity.


