God's Word is Enough



The Bible is not only necessary for a person to be saved and to know how to live a life of following Jesus, but it is sufficient to that end as well. The Bible does not contain everything there is to know about God or how and why He works, but it contains everything we **need** to know. There is nothing lacking in the words of Scripture. There is no other resource to discover the words of our creator. The Bible may not give every answer, but it gives all we need *"that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work"* (2 Tim. 3:15-17).

Now, here is where many people have issues...No other opinions or thoughts or traditions are to be put on equal footing with the Bible. Where scripture does not give the answers, we are free to give suggestions or thoughts, but should never suggest that those ideas are God's ideas. He has given us all He wants to say in the Bible, at this time, and there are no outside revelations from God apart from what is already recorded in the written word of God. Is that something that you can claim to believe? Do you believe that God didn't forget to include something in His word, or add something that is not necessary? We cannot add or take away from the holy writ of Scripture with our preferences or opinions and presume that God shares those opinions and preferences. We must not speak dogmatically where Scripture is silent.

God did not intend for his holy word to be used as a weapon to tear down our brothers and sisters in moments of disagreements. The Bible aims to reveal God to us, to expose our sinful state and need for salvation, to tell us of the Savior Jesus, and to lead us to follow Him through repentance and faith. It is the final authority on truth and is perfectly inerrant in its original form. God's word is clear and able to make wise the simple. The Bible is the complete revelation, perfectly sufficient to accomplish all God intends.

"Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth." John 17:17
