Why do you do what you do? What is the thing that you are working towards? The world tells us that the purpose of work is to accumulate fame and fortune for ourselves. If one wants to make a name for themselves and prove to the world that they are important, valuable, and worthy, then they have to work for it.



That's how we measure ourselves and everyone around us, right? We will automatically think more highly of a person who has achieved for themselves a reputable position in a reputable occupation. As I am typing this I am simultaneously looking up some synonyms of the word "reputable". Here are just a few of what I found: "well-thought-of, highly regarded, respected, well respected, respectable, of (good) repute, prestigious, established". This is what we spend our lives seeking. "Do good in school so you can get scholarships to a reputable college to get a reputable education. With that reputable education, get yourself a reputable job that pays well so you can support your family. Then, and only then, will you be a reputable person yourself." But what makes us like this? Why do we want so badly for people to view us as "reputable"?

Ever since Adam and Eve bit into the forbidden apple in the Garden of Eden, we have been trying to cover up our sin nature, not with fig leaves, but with our accomplishments. We think that if we get all the things our culture says are reputable and worthwhile, we will be able to mask our human condition. Essentially, we use our work as a means of saving ourselves.

For the Christian, the work of Jesus Christ should be the ultimate measure of value of our life, and nothing else. When Jesus said, "It is finished," we no longer have to use our work as a means of saving ourselves.

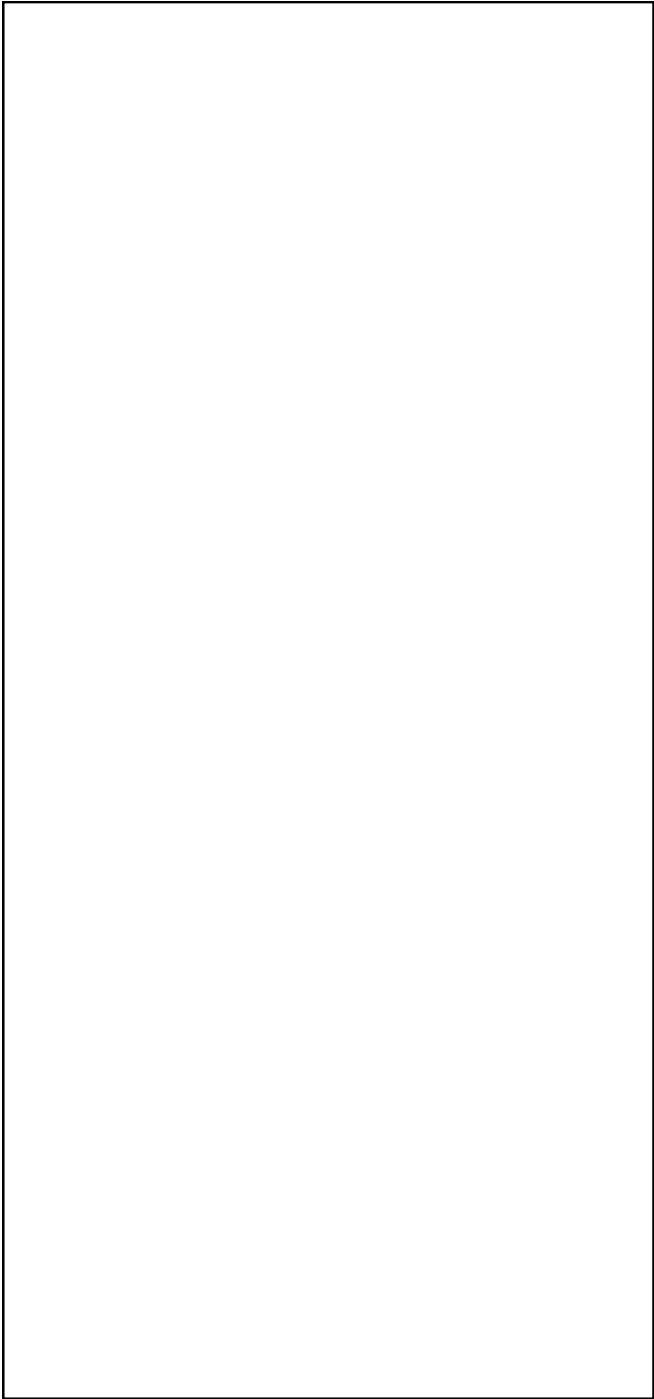
